- Increase to 80% of students receiving "C" or above in English and Mathematics.
- Increase human resources (HR) to provide intervention, differentiation support and learning engagement, to achieve at year level and above expectations.
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands in Reading, Writing and Numeracy.
- Increase the percentage of students at or above National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading, Writing and Numeracy.

- Provision of extensive professional development for teachers and teacher aides through implementing a comprehensive support framework to build capability in targeted areas of Reading, Writing and Numeracy.
