#### This funding will be used to

- Increase Human Resources (HR) to provide intervention and differentiation support to achieve at year level and above expectations
- Focus on student and staff wellbeing by building skill sets that will support personalised learning, enabling our school community to flourish in a positive learning environment
- Improve student engagement in learning by implementing 4 out of 7 stages of the Reboot program schoolwide, by the end of 2019
- Increase expectations that 80% of Prep Year 6 students achieve the equivalent of "C" or above for English and Mathematics
- Implement intervention and target teaching programs in Prep to Year 2 focusing on the development of oral language, phonological awareness, writing and reading

- Provision of extensive professional development for teachers and teacher aides through implementing a comprehensive support framework to build capability in targeted areas of wellbeing and student engagement
- Improving student outcomes based on early intervention through data analysis in Writing, Reading and Numeracy
- Increasing teacher aide support schoolwide, focussing on intervention and differentiation in Writing, Reading and Numeracy
- Continuing to improve teacher capability in data analysis to inform planning, intervention and differentiation focusing on improving student outcomes in Writing, Reading and Numeracy
- Increasing HR resources to support existing Oral Language and Early Years Intervention Programs
- Continuing the LEAP program (Learning Enrichment Around iPads) a learning engagement initiative, utilising digital technology
